## ENDORSEMENTS ISSUED FOR:

### 1. SELF-LOADING FIREARMS

- a. Carbines: **Sport only**
- b. Rifles: **Sport - Hunting** (If Province Proclamations allow - listed species ) – only applicants in that Province
- c. Shotguns: **Sport - Hunting** (of birds, pigs, and other small problem animals)
- d. (i) Pistol calibre type carbines: **Sport only**  
(ii) Hand machine carbines:
- e. Pistols: **Sport - Hunting** if described as back for coup de grace shots when animals are wounded (final death shot - "genade skoot"). But that must be clearly stated in the motivation.  
Calibres must be bigger than .44 Desert Eagle (minimum 100mm barrel length)

### 2. MANUALLY OPERATED FIREARMS

- a. Rifles: *Bolt action* – **Sport - Hunt** (
- b. Rimfire rifles: All actions – **Sport – Hunt** – groundbirds and small animals)  
Shotguns:
  - (i) Over & Under - **Sport** (all exercises) - **Hunt** (gamebirds, warthogs, bushpigs, feral pigs, and other small problem animals)
  - (ii) Side by Side - **Sport.** (All exercises) - **Hunt** (gamebirds, warthogs, bushpigs, feral pigs, and other small problem animals)
  - (iii) Pump action - **Sport.** (gongs and limit clays preferably longer barrels for trap). Obviously other organisations shotgun exercises
  - (iv) Protecta. - **Sport** (Mainly gongs and other organisations shotgun exercises) – **Hunt** (pigs, and other small problem animals)
  - (v) Hand-shotgun - **Sport** (Mainly gongs. and other organisations Hand-shotgun exercises).

c. Revolvers and Pistols;

**Sport** (All handgun calibres and any Natshoot or other association's exercises or targets)

**Hunt** (Bigger than 357 mag, minimum 100mm barrel – Pistols Calibres such as >.44 Desert Eagle's. In smaller calibres than above then described as back for coup de grace shots when animals are wounded (final death shot - "genade skoot". But that must be clearly stated in the motivation. Bigger than 357 mag, minimum 100mm barrel) - if described as backup for *coup de grace* shots when animals are wounded (final death shot - "genade skoot". But that must be clearly stated in the motivation.
