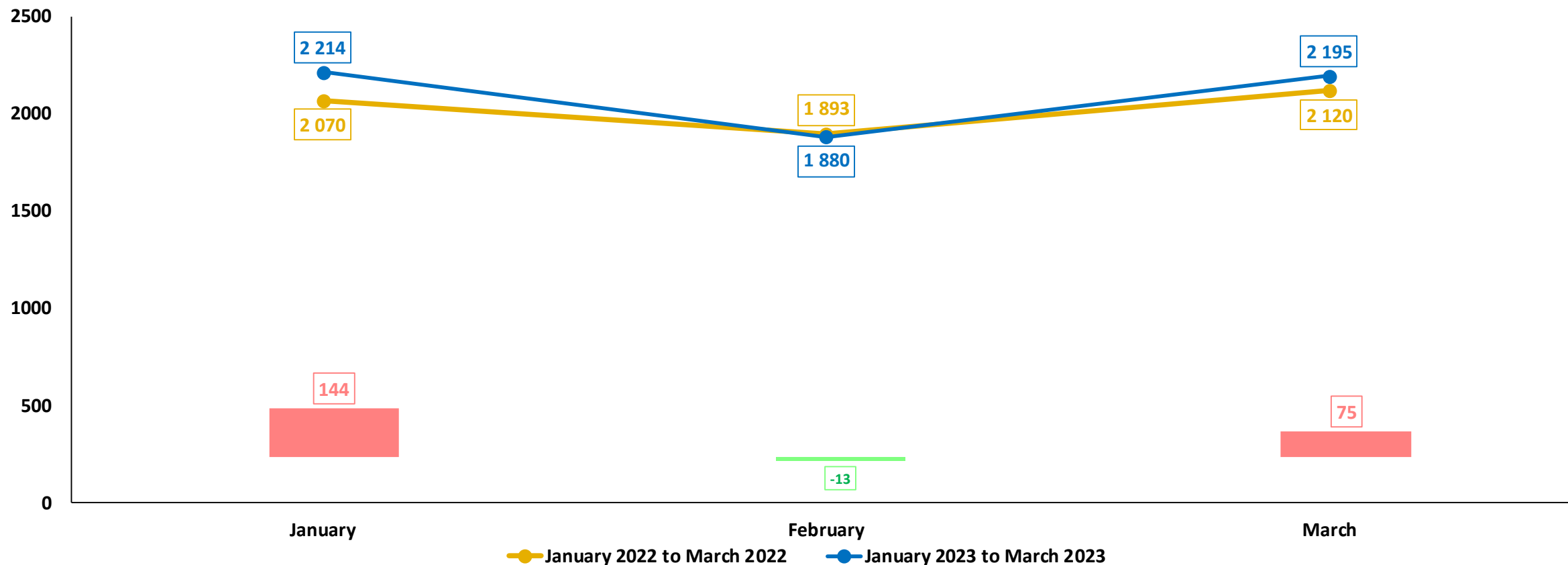

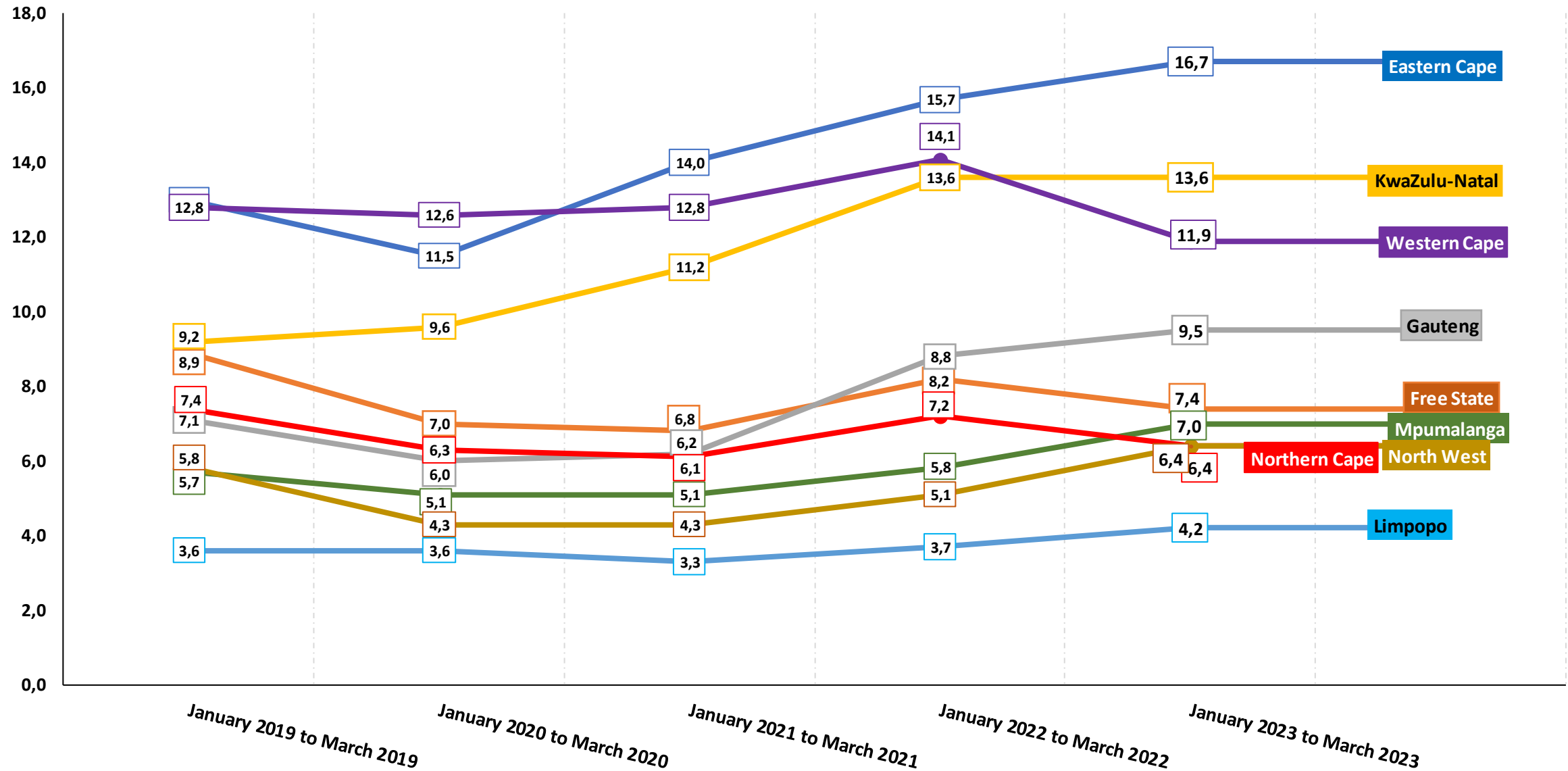

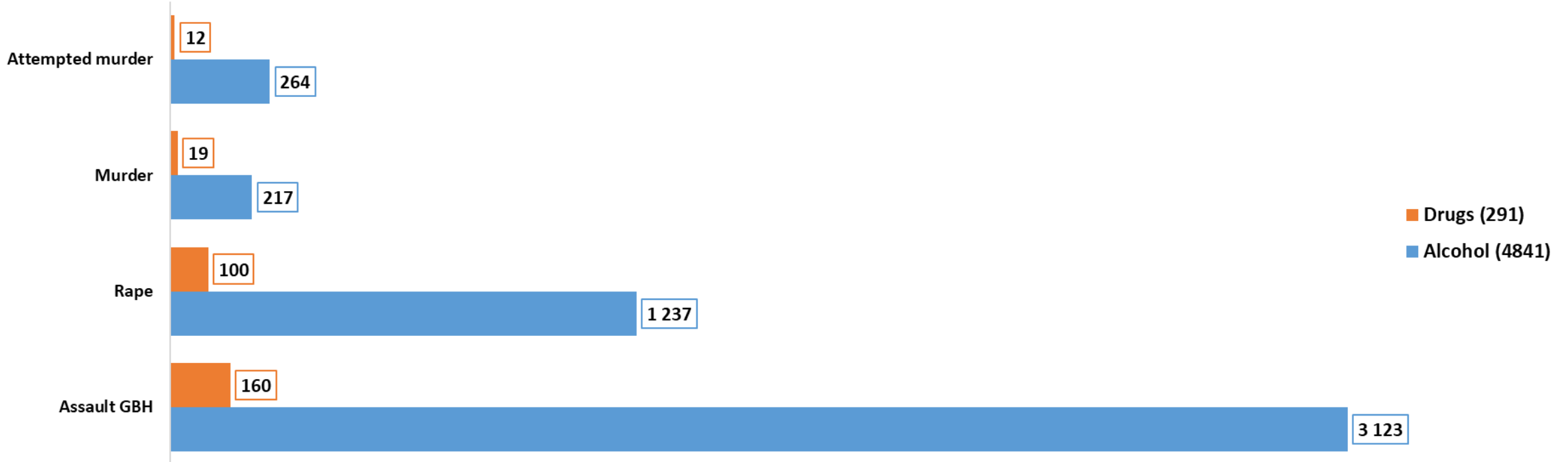

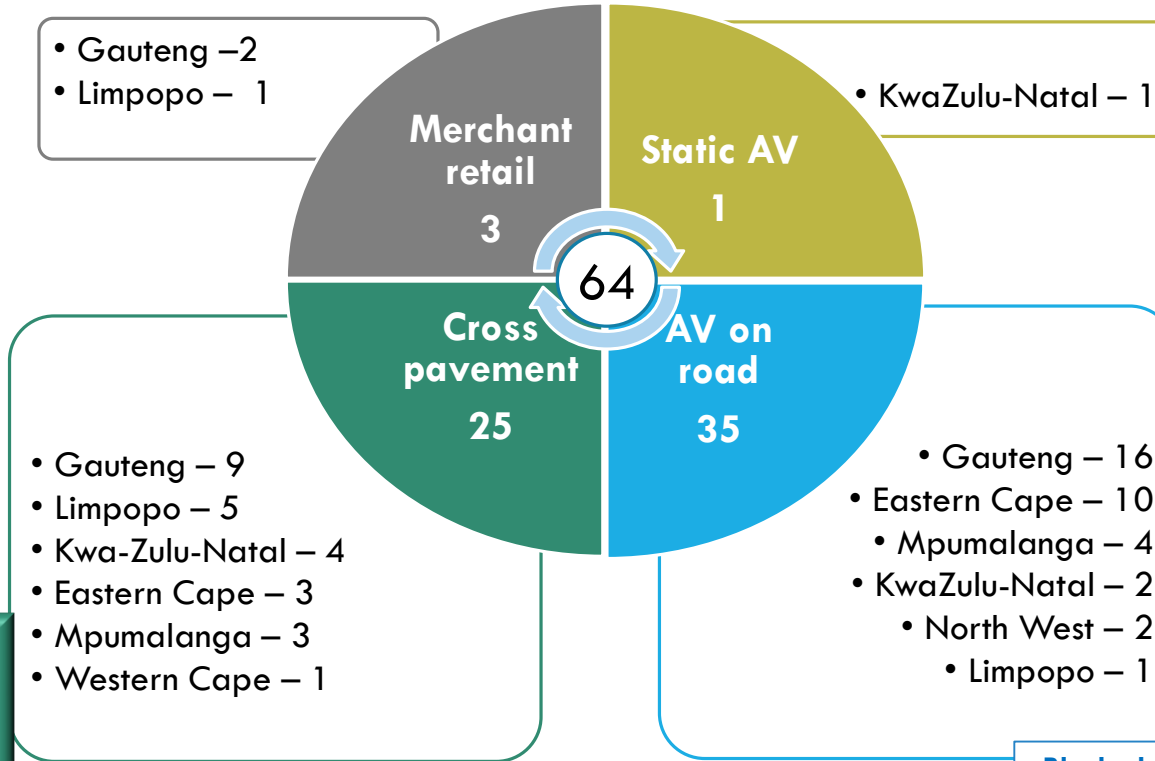

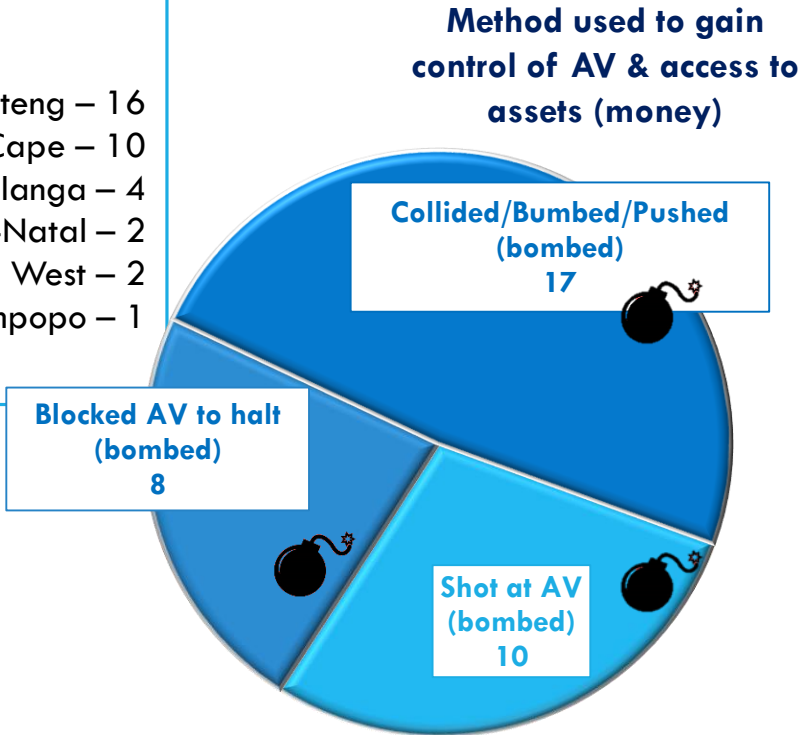
ROBBERY OF CASH IN TRANSIT (CIT)

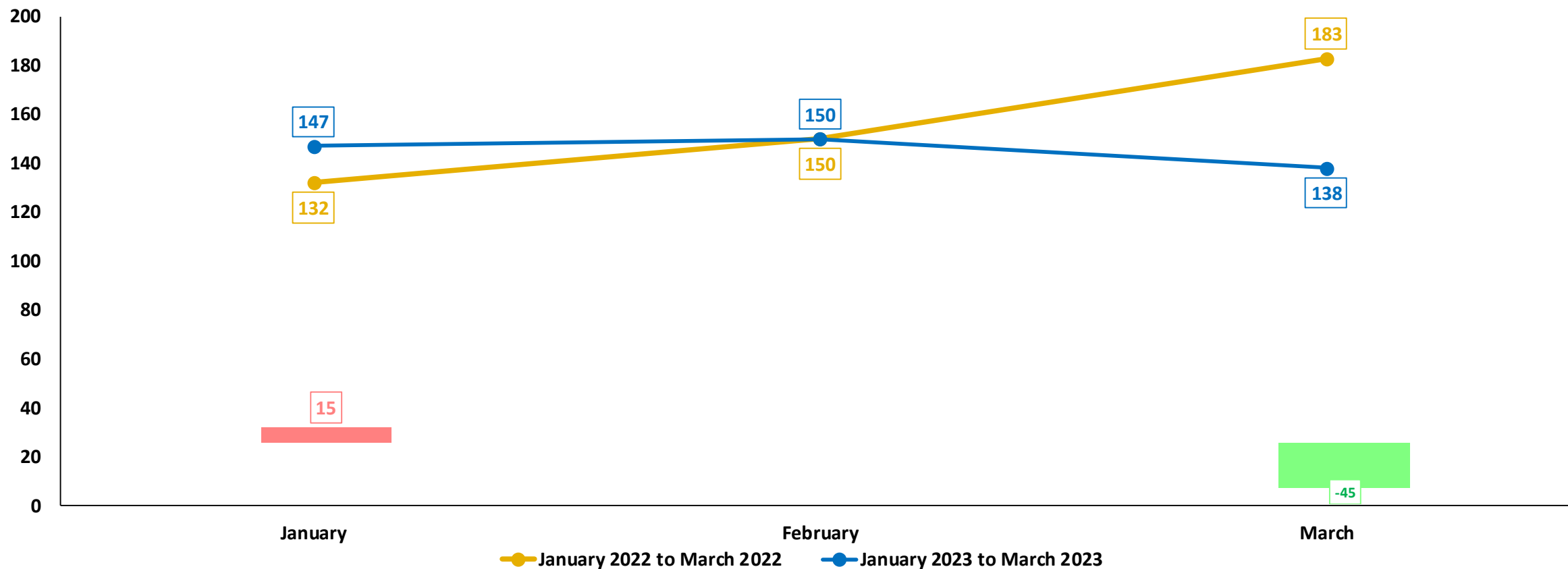
